Known Issues in 5.5.1:

- In order to fix the problem where the InstallAnywhere Variable \$PRODUCT_NAME\$ can reference the value of \$INSTALLER_TITLE\$, it is necessary to change existing locale files. Please delete the generated locale files, or simply remove the property "installer.productname" from all the locale files.
- Windows Server 2003 returns different values for the java property os.name depending which Java Virtual Machine it runs against. It can return both "Windows XP" and "Windows 2003".

Changes since 5.5.0:

- FEATURE: Added ability to choose which VM to run from for graphical Mac OS X LaunchAnywhere executables
- Added "Windows 2003" to the Check platform rule
- Debug output no longer appears every time for console installers running on DEC systems
- Fixed problem where the Pre-Install Summary Panel could display HTML instead of rendering it
- Fixed situation where the order of actions imported through a merge module could change
- Fixed problem where the setJavaVMList method of the InstallerResources class wouldn't function correctly
- Fixed problem where the InstallAnywhere Variable \$PRODUCT_NAME\$ would reference the value of \$INSTALLER_TITLE\$
- Fixed resource loading with Mac OS X CD-ROM installers
- Fixed problem where uninstaller referenced installer localization string
- Fixed issue where disk space checking would return incorrect data on IRIX and DEC systems
- Fixed problems loading XML install script on systems with EBCDIC encoding (including OS/390)
- Fixed problem where file overwriting would complain when creating multiple shortcuts with the same custom icons
- Fixed problem where properties set in installer.properties files would overwrite values passed in on the command line
- Fixed problem where UNIX resources would not get correctly compressed for CD-ROM installers
- Fixed issue with checking disk space when not bundling a Java VM
- Enhanced disk space checking on UNIX systems with large numbers of mounted volumes
- Edited the locale files to remove double quotes
- Fixed problem where RPM registration could fail if files had spaces in their names
- Addressed problems with Set System Environment Variable action on Windows 2003
- Fixed problem where pure java installers could fail to install Merge Modules under certain conditions
- Fixed problem where InstallAnywhere would expect a different java os.name property for Windows Server 2003 running Java 1.4.2
